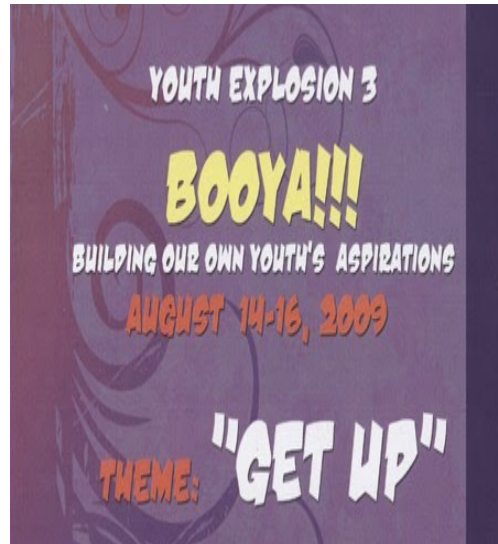

## Rev. Joseph Lowery "Presidential Medal of Freedom"

President Barack Obama is awarding the Presidential Medal of Freedom to 16 people, including the Rev. Joseph Lowery, a leader in the civil rights movements since the 1950s.

Rev. Lowery helped organize the Montgomery bus boycott. He later co-founded the Southern Christian Leadership Conference with the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr.

The medals, representing the nation's highest honor for a civilian, and is the first to be awarded by President Obama. He will present them at a White House ceremony on August 12, 2009.

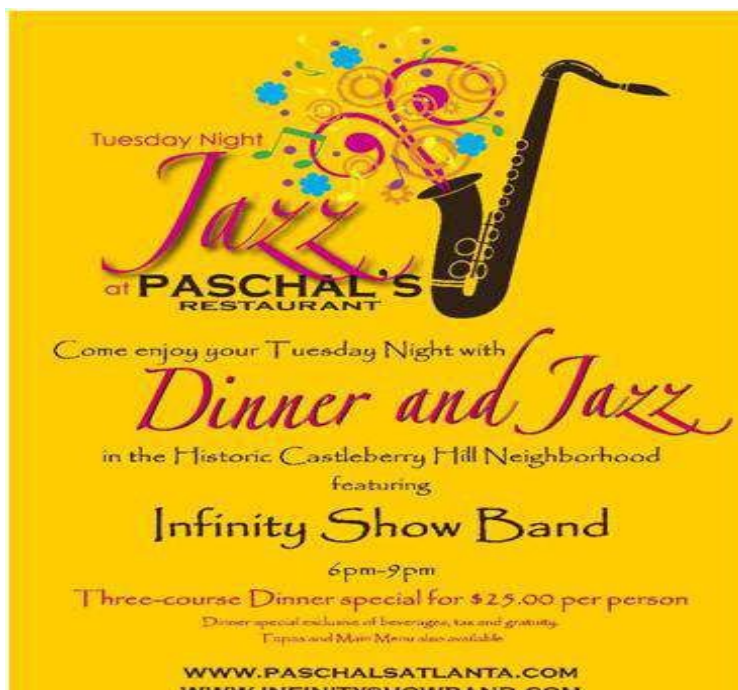
